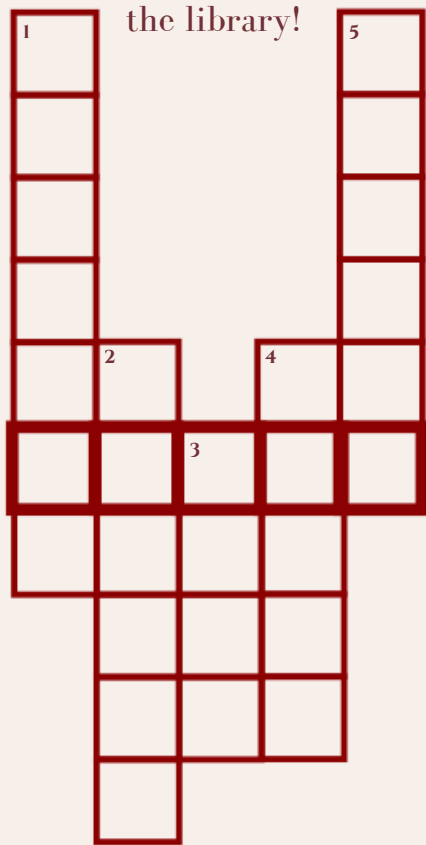


Firstly, complete this crossword to reveal the hidden keyword. This word is your only key to the next puzzle—solve it to find the final code and help me escape
