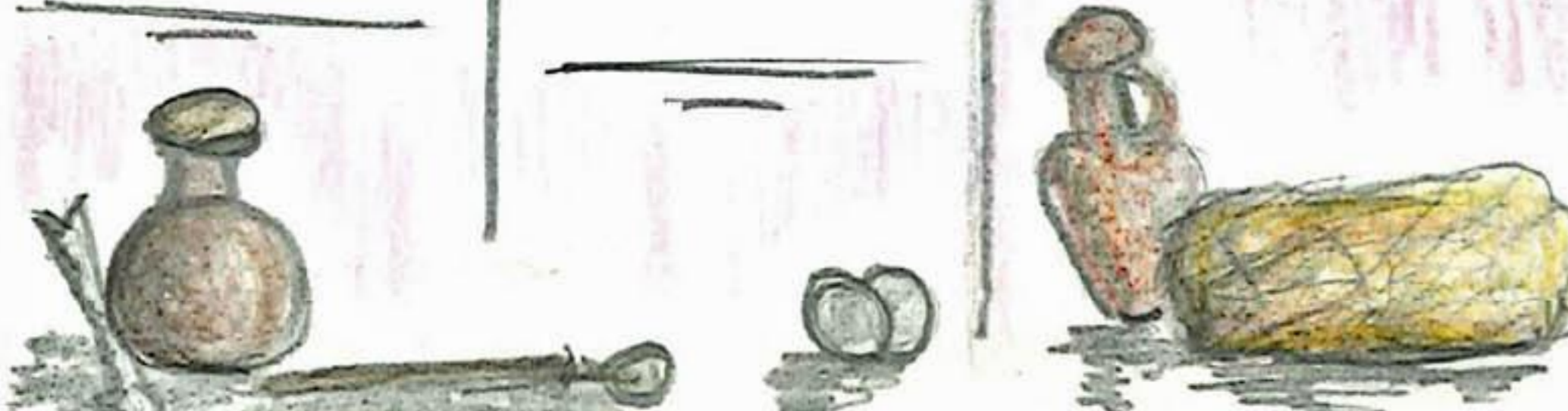


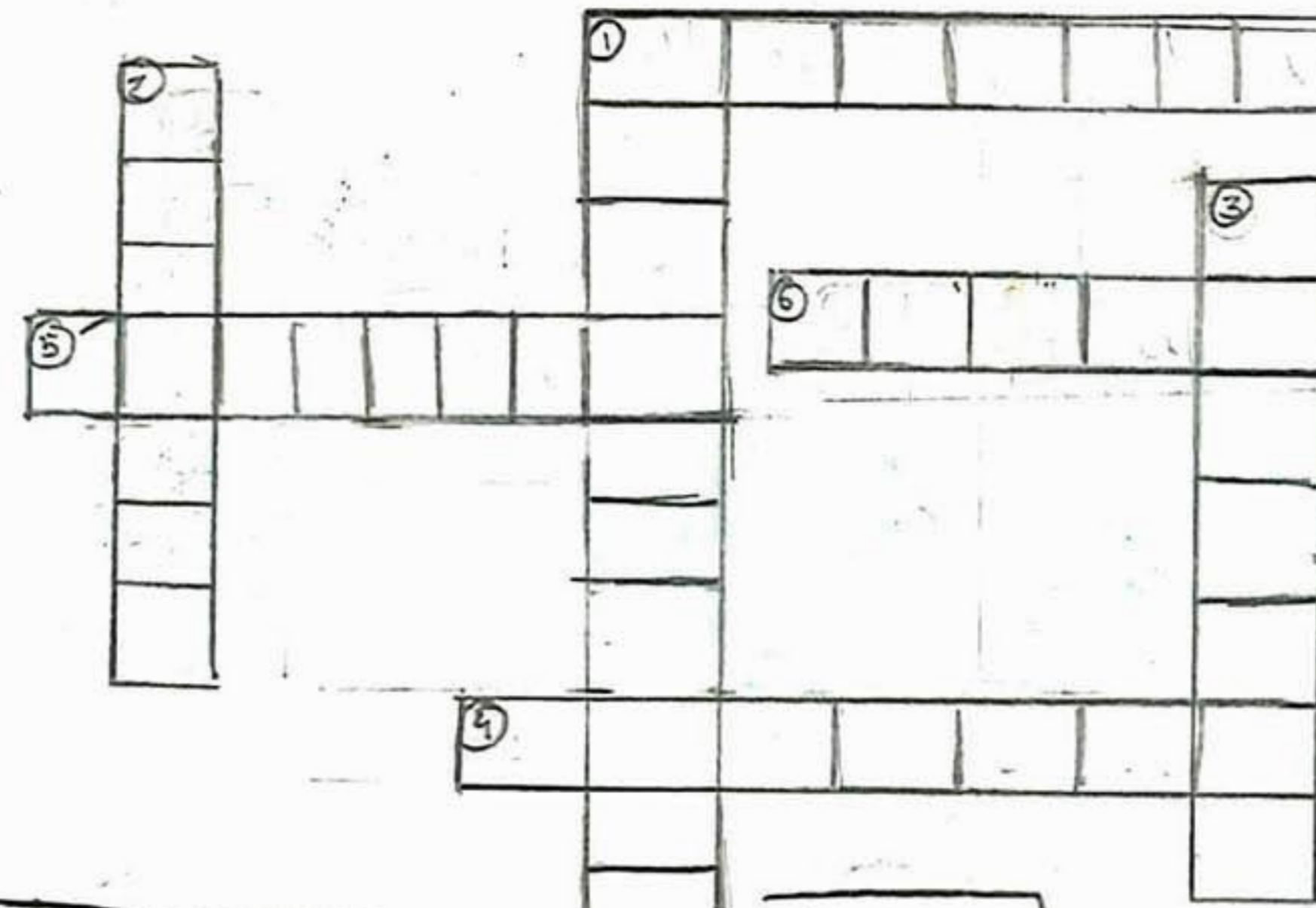

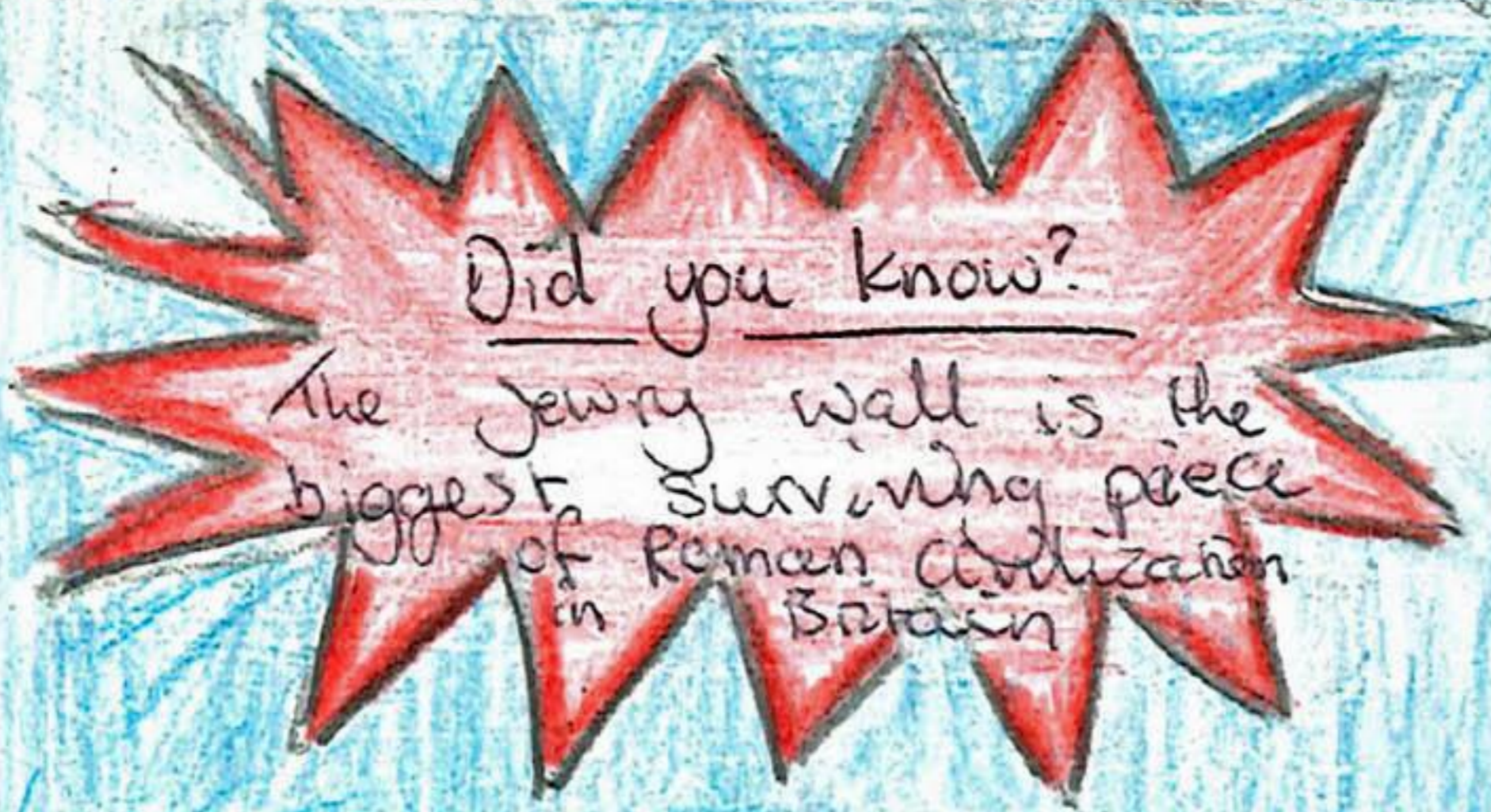
### Introduction:
